DRIVE SAFE PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

To assist and help members of our DSNSG families with ASD, ADHD, and Asperger's to gain confidence and self-esteem when learning to drive (16 years and above). This program was developed because we recognised that people with a disability needed specialised training and assistance to gain their driving licence. Having a licence will likely make job hunting more accessible to these young men and women and in turn help reduce the financial strain of having a special need.

This program is sponsored by Aspen Medical and DSNSG.

CONTRIBUTION

Families will need to pay a contribution towards the Driving Lessons to be eligible for this program.

E.g. Driving Lessons x 10, 1 hr lessons \$995

Aspen Medical pay 1/3 of cost \$331.66

DSNSG \$331.66 and families \$331.66

Once the application has been approved, and letter of acceptance will be sent to the families with the bank details to pay the contribution.

PROCESS

- Send an email of expression of interest to drivesafe@dsnsg.org.au
- Fill in application form and supply medical supporting documentation
- Program coordinator will check that all criteria's have been met.
- Letter of acceptance or not accept will be sent. **(Letter of acceptance is only valid for 30 days)**
- If applicant has been approved, payment details will be sent purchase of Driving Lessons will be take place.

CRITERIA

- Be a member of DSNSG for minimal of 6 months
- Supply supporting documentation (ASD, ADHD, Asperger's).
- Family can pay the contribution towards to the Driving Lessons **(Invoice is only valid for 30 days)**
- Must hold current drivers licence
